ANNOUNCEMENTS FOR CALVARY CHAPEL IN ROCKLAND

CHURCH CLOSING:

Governor Charlie Baker issued a stay-at-home advisory for the Commonwealth beginning at noon on Tuesday, March 24. All non-essential businesses have been ordered to close and residents are urged to stay at home during this time period, **this order has been extended through May 4th**. His order limits gatherings to **10** people during the state of emergency. This includes community, civic, public, leisure, faith-based events, and any similar event or activity that brings together more than **10** persons in any confined **indoor or outdoor** space. Grocery stores, restaurants (take out) and medical facilities are still open. We continue to communicate through the church website so you can know the status of church services and other information as it is known to us. *All ministries, **no matter the size** are cancelled, this includes home ministries.*
